## Accessibility

- Greenbrier Valley Airport is located 10 minutes from Lewisburg and 20 minutes from The Greenbrier
- Amtrak Service to White Sulphur Springs and Alderson on the Cardinal Route
- I-64 passes through the county with exits at Sam Black, Alderson, Lewisburg and Caldwell
- US Rt. 219 and US Rt. 60 intersect in Lewisburg
- 66 percent of US population is located within 500 miles of the reenbrier Valley

## Attractions

- Historic downtown Lewisburg is a vibrant, four-block district featuring 14 independent dining establishments and a eclectic mix of boutique shops and galleries
- Greenbrier Valley Theatre, The State Professional Theatre of West Virginia offers main stage theatrical productions, concerts, art exhibits and youth programing
- One of only four still in operation worldwide, Lewisburg’s Carnegie Hall remains an arts and education center with regular performances, classes, films and lectures
- With multiple access points, the 78-mile Greenbrier River Trail attracts bikers, hikers and horseback riders from all across the mid-Atlantic
- Two ancient cave networks can be toured in Greenbrier County -- Lost World Caverns and Organ Cave
- Three libations call the area home, Greenbrier Valley Brewing Company, Smooth Ambler Spirits and Hawk Knob Appalachian Hard Cider & Mead

- Kate's Mountain has some of the best views of the valley -- get there by hiking Young's Trail in the Greenbrier State Forest
- The Greenbrier Classic takes place in July on the Old White TPC course at The Greenbrier
- The State Fair of West Virginia is a 164-year tradition in Greenbrier County
